

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Is there a limit to the number of people allowed in meetings?**
Each meeting will cap at 10 participants.
- 2. How do I sign up for a meeting? Can I just show up?**
You must call ahead on the day of the meeting to sign-up for an available spot. Call 207-553-2575 to reserve your seat.
- 3. Are masks required?**
Yes. **Masks must be worn at all times** covering nose, mouth and chin. No one will be allowed in the center without a mask on.
- 4. What happens when I arrive at PRCC?**
You will line up outside, spaced out 6 ft apart standing on designated markers. We will have a small table set-up outside the front door with one staff member who will take your temperature and ask a series of pre-screening questions. One person will be screened at a time to enter PRCC. Please arrive to the meeting at least 15 minutes early to ensure time for this process. When you enter the building, a second staff member or volunteer will sign you in.
- 5. What room are the meetings in?**
All meetings will take place in the large meeting room in the front of the building. There will be 10 chairs set up 6 ft apart with marks on the floor. When the meeting is complete all attendees will exit out the Forest Avenue door. We will have a staff member prop open the door and have hand sanitizer available for people exiting.
- 6. Can I still attend virtually?**
YES! We encourage everyone to still participate in virtual meetings and we will continue to update our schedule. For the in-person meetings, we will have a laptop all set up prior to the meeting starting for the group leader to log into Zoom for the virtual option of the meeting.
- 7. Can I meet with sponsees or others in the small rooms?**
At this time, all other rooms will be off limits. The front meeting room and only use the bathroom in the conference room.
- 8. Is there still coffee?**
Unfortunately, there will be no food or drink allowed in the center at this time.
- 9. I miss hanging out at PRCC. Can I just come hang out like the old days?**
We miss you too! We will continue phased opening of the center as it is determined safe to do so by the state and CDC guidelines. Right now, the health and safety of our members comes first. For now, we can't have people hanging out on PRCC property other than to attend a meeting or coaching. Smoking is off limits too. But don't worry, one day we will be together again!
- 10. How do you keep everything clean?**
Once everyone leaves the meeting we will clean and sanitize the meeting room and bathroom immediately. We have a thorough checklist to sanitize everything and keep the environment safe.
