**Glossary:**

**Recovery Coach Basics**

*(The introductory class for those interested in becoming a recovery coach and for community members, allies.)*

This curriculum delivers a more basic, introductory version of the Recovery Coach Academy in a one-day training session. It focuses on the foundational principles of Recovery Coaching, so participants may become more familiar with recovery, stigma, and other core concepts.

**Recovery Coach Academy**

*(For those wanting to become a recovery coach)*

The CCAR Recovery Coach Academy© is a 5-day intensive training academy focusing on providing individuals with the skills need to guide, mentor and support anyone who would like to enter into or sustain long-term recovery from an addiction to alcohol, or other drugs.

**Ethical Considerations for Recovery Coaches**

*(For trained CCAR recovery coaches)*

A training designed to help coaches and anyone else working in the peer role to understand how critical it is to be ethically responsible.

**Coachervision**

*(For trained CCAR recovery coaches who will be supervising recovery coaches)*

This curriculum will provide participants with an understanding of how-to best support coaches day-to-day and develop coaches for long-term success.

**Recovery Coaching in an Emergency Department**

*(For trained CCAR recovery coaches)*

A training designed to help coaches develop skills to advocate and educate staff, patients and others while working in an Emergency Department.
