Glossary:

Recovery Coach Basics

(The introductory class for those interested in becoming a recovery coach and for community members, allies.)

This curriculum delivers a more basic, introductory version of the Recovery Coach Academy in a one-day training session. It focuses on the foundational principles of Recovery Coaching, so participants may become more familiar with recovery, stigma, and other core concepts.

Recovery Coach Academy

(For those wanting to become a recovery coach)

The CCAR Recovery Coach Academy© is a 5-day intensive training academy focusing on providing individuals with the skills need to guide, mentor and support anyone who would like to enter into or sustain long-term recovery from an addiction to alcohol, or other drugs.

Ethical Considerations for Recovery Coaches

(For trained CCAR recovery coaches)

A training designed to help coaches and anyone else working in the peer role to understand how critical it is to be ethically responsible.

Coachervision

(For trained CCAR recovery coaches who will be supervising recovery coaches)

This curriculum will provide participants with an understanding of how-to best support coaches day-to-day and develop coaches for long-term success.

Recovery Coaching in an Emergency Department

(For trained CCAR recovery coaches)

A training designed to help coaches develop skills to advocate and educate staff, patients and others while working in an Emergency Department.
